Activity for June 2009

Convert-to-Life - Antoinette Wilson

- 20 women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers (7 of the turnaways were reported by Love Thy Neighbor Dallas); 9 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 161 turnaways, 68 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,113. Accepted SWC literature: 29.65%; accepted aftercare literature: 7.01%. Total sidewalk counseling coverage at all centers: 99%.

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Caryn Stevens

- Received a total of 10 calls on the 214-544-CARE helpline, 36 calls on the 972-679-4760 Spanish helpline and 18 emails through www.racheldallas.org for information on help and healing and the ministry
- Held our 15th Rachel's Vineyard Retreat™ in Spanish. We have now had a total of 50 retreats (35 English and 15 Spanish) in Dallas!
- Trained a volunteer for the English retreats and will put her into service on the August 21-23 retreat
