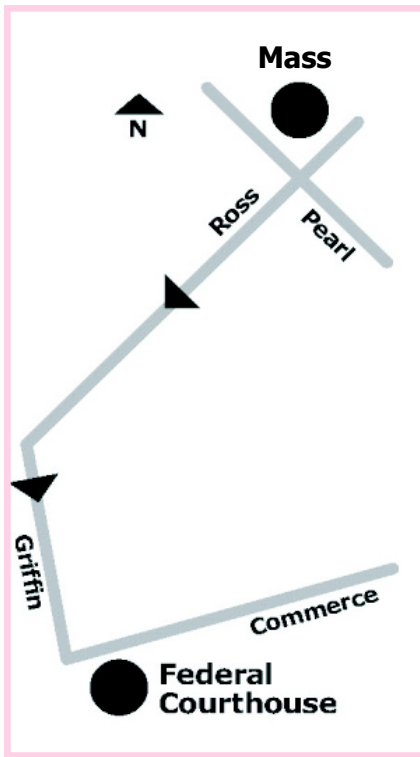
ROSARY, MASS, RALLY & DALLAS MARCH FOR LIFE

- 8:00-8:45 a.m.** Pray the 2010 **Roe Memorial Rosary** at the Routh Street abortion center, 4321 N. Central Expy, Dallas
- 10:00 a.m.** Bilingual **Roe Memorial Mass, Cathedral Shrine of the Virgin of Guadalupe**, concelebrated by **Bishops Farrell & Vann** with diocesan clergy. Music led by **Curtis Stephan**.
- 12:00 p.m.** **Ecumenical Dallas March for Life & Rally** from the **Cathedral Plaza** to the **Earle Cabell Federal Courthouse** where Roe v. Wade was first filed in 1970, with prayers for the overturning of Roe v. Wade and for legal protection to be restored to our unborn brothers and sisters once again.
